Before you visit

Changes in cleaning:

- we have increased our cleaning procedures, in both the public and staff areas;
- hand sanitisers are available in both buildings.



When you enter the Library or No 5:

- you will see signage encouraging you to follow social distancing requirements and discouraging anyone from entering if suffering from COVID symptoms;
- hand sanitisers are available at both entrances, so please use them;
- please remove medical gloves and dispose of them in the pedal bins provided so that you may use the sanitiser.

While in the Library or No 5:

- you will be welcomed by staff members who will guide you to go in the right direction around the building and exhibitions, and to do so in your own time and with safety;
- please ensure that you remain socially distanced from others while in either building;
- our information flyers will be made available but are not currently on display in quantities, so that they remain safe for you to use, when you request them. When you finish your visit and if you do not want to take the information flyer with you, please dispose of it in the bin which is labelled for that use;
- there are activity sheets for our younger visitors and again they are not on display in numbers, in order to keep them safe to use;
- we continue to stock a number of items for purchase. We have one sample of everything on display and will supply you with items from a separate and safe stock;
- we have a card reader for you to purchase items and to give donations, to avoid the need for cash.
