## Early English books in Armagh Public Library: a short-title catalogue of books printed before 1641

Armagh Public Library was founded in 1771 by the then Archbishop of Armagh, Richard Robinson, first Baron Rokeby. 1 The Library's collection of printed books is particularly rich in British and European publications of the eighteenth century, but there are also four Continental incunabula and a substantial number of books of the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries. Among the latter are some three hundred works which were printed within the British Isles or at English presses operating abroad in such places as Douai, St Omer and Amsterdam, prior to 1641. Most of these items, together with approximately 22,000 other volumes printed before 1801, are recorded in the manuscript catalogue of the Library compiled by a former Keeper, the Very Rev William Reeves, and completed by him in 1867. This remarkable and, for the most part, very accurate catalogue provides an invaluable guide to the collection but it remains unpublished, and many scholars and bibliographers who have not visited the

Library must be unaware of what books it contains.

The compilation of this short-title list of the English books published before 1641 has a two-fold purpose. Some published account and updated list of these early books was clearly desirable, especially for scholars working in Ireland. In addition it was felt that such a list would be a useful contribution to the records of the Bibliographical Society in its revision of the Short-title catalogue of English books 1475-1640, compiled by A W Pollard and G R Redgrave and published in 1926. Miss K F Pantzer, who is overseeing the revision work at the Houghton Library of Harvard University, had details of STC holdings in a number of Irish libraries not included in the first edition of the Catalogue, ie those of Magee College, Queen's University, Derry and Raphoe Diocese, Cashel Cathedral and the Linen Hall Library in Belfast. There were only a few records for Armagh, including that of Sarpi's Interdictu Veniti historia (STC 21767.5), with the unique Cambridge imprint of 1630, which had been noted by the late Professor Jackson who had visited Armagh during the 1950s. A full list of the Armagh holdings increases our knowledge of those STC titles which are held in British Isles collections, and in particular of those which may be consulted in Irish libraries.

Like Archbishop Marsh's Library in Dublin, the Armagh Public Library is an independent foundation established by Act of Parliament<sup>2</sup> and under the control of a Board of Governors and Guardians. Although it is not Church property the Library has nevertheless always had the closest links with the Church of Ireland in a number of ways. No layman was appointed to the Board until 1886, and the Act requires that the Keeper shall be an Anglican clergyman . The nucleus of the collection was Archbishop

Robinson's personal library and several more clerical collections have been acquired during the past two centuries. It is not surprising therefore that the majority of these early books should relate to theology, canon law, doctrinal controversy and related matters. Nevertheless a wide range of subjects including philosophy, classical and modern literature, voyages and travel, heraldry, history and law are also represented.

The task of listing the following titles was begun in 1974, initially with a list of entries culled from Reeves' catalogue 4 and later with notes made during a physical search of the shelves, especially those in the gallery of the main room of the Library where the majority of these books are kept. Three hundred and two books and pamphlets have been noted. Entries are, mutatis mutandis, in general accordance with those in the Short title catalogue, and items have been numbered using the STC numbering. In a few instances (eg STC 12771.5; 17936.5) the numbering as in the revised edition of the STC has been used. Many of the abbreviations used by the STC in describing the imprints of books have been adopted in the interests of brevity. The appropriate shelf-mark or finding-reference has been added to each entry, and the presence of multiple copies has been indicated by the listing of two or more shelf-marks. Where a work is incomplete or seriously defective this has also been noted. In five instances it has not been possible for technical reasons to print the Greek portion of a title in Greek characters. Many of these books bear ownership inscriptions, marginalia, bookplates and other indications of provenance, and some are of interest for their bindings and other features. It has not, however, been possible to include details of these within the scope of this list.

Finally, the work of compilation was made particularly interesting by the discovery of two pamphlets which were hitherto unrecorded. Both are to be included in the forthcoming first volume (section A-H) of the revised STC, scheduled for 1980, and identifying numbers have not yet been assigned to them. A rather more detailed entry has been accorded to these items, which precede the main list.

The compiler would like to thank Miss K F Pantzer who dealt patiently with many bibliographical queries and problems. Her assistance and encouragement were quite invaluable. He would also like to thank the Keeper of the Library, the Very Rev H A Lillie, Dean of Armagh, and Mrs Lillie, for their help and warm hospitality while he was working in the Library.


